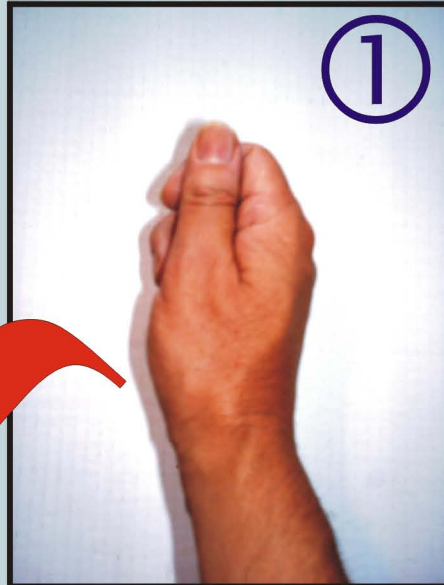

# **CARRIER SALUTE**
